

# BINDING MECHANISMS



## Round Rings:

The round ring is the traditional and the most economical. Mounted on the spine or the back cover, the rivets can be exposed or concealed at an extra charge. Capacity is limited due to the fact that it is not possible to utilize the full width of the ring without crimping the pages. Capacity is measured horizontally across the widest point of the ring. Available capacities range from 1/2" - 3" including a 3" oval ring.



## D Ring:

Mounted on the back cover the D-Ring will keep the pages stationary as the binder is opened or closed. Capacity is measured along the straight edge and comes in sizes from 1" - 2 1/2."



## Angle-D:

Angle-D rings are comparable in capacity to the D-Rings, but require less total width of a binder. The pages will stay stationary when the binder is opened or closed. The softer angle between the straight edge and the rounded portion allow for easy page turning. Available capacities range from 1" - 3."

## Multiple Rings:
